All stable reservations and entries in stakes and all other races are received and accepted subject to all conditions, rules, and regulations of the California Horse Racing Board and Santa Anita Park.

Santa Anita Park reserves the right to refuse the application for stable space or the entry or the acceptance of a transfer of any entry for any cause and without notice to the subscriber.

No stable reservation or entry in any race will be received except upon the condition that all disputes, claims, and objections arising out of the racing or with respect to the interpretation of any rules or conditions of races or otherwise shall be decided by the California Horse Racing Board, the Stewards of the meeting, or Santa Anita Park, and such decisions upon all points shall be final.

Santa Anita Park reserves the right to cancel any race at any time prior to the actual running thereof, for any reason and without liability, except for the return of nomination and entry fees paid.

Santa Anita Park reserves the right to start all races with or without a stall gate starting machine.

TRACK SPECIFICATIONS

Main Track

The Santa Anita Park main track is a one-mile oval with seven-furlong and 1 1/4 –mile chutes. The surface is comprised of a mixture of 90% sand, 10% rubber, fiber and polymer..

The track is maintained by a crew led by Santa Anita’s track superintendent Richard Tedesco. Horsemen with questions regarding the track surface and maintenance can contact the superintendent at 626-574-6452.

Distance from the top of the stretch to the wire 900 feet
Width of dirt course..... 85 feet

Training Hours – Main Track

Regular training hours will commence at 4:45 a.m. and conclude at 10:00 a.m. There will be one maintenance break on the main track, at 7:30 a.m., and two breaks on the training track Announcements alerting horsemen to upcoming breaks will be made by security personnel. At the appropriate times, the outriders will clear all horses from the track to ensure that the tractors are able to harrow the surface in a timely manner.

Turf Course

Santa Anita has two different turf courses, a 6 acre Hill course and a 10 acre Oval, which were completely rebuilt in 1996. The profile now consists of a 4” Peagravel base, followed by a 7” USGA layer. The top portion of the course consists of 5” sand and soil mix with a fibrillated fiber called Turf grids mixed evenly throughout the Bermuda grass. During the Santa Anita meet, the Bermuda is overseeded with Rye, which takes us through the cooler racing weather.

TRACK SPECIFICATIONS AND TRAINING HOURS

Main Track

The Gulfstream Park main track surface is comprised of a mixture of 85.5% sand and 14.5% clay, with a cushion measuring 3 3/4” in depth supported by a 7” compacted pad of the same material. Beneath the pad is a 12” sand base on top of approximately 8” of road rock.

The track is maintained by a crew led by Gulfstream’s track superintendent. Horsemen with questions regarding the track surface and maintenance can contact the superintendent at 954-457-6212.

Distance from the top of the stretch to the wire 1228 feet
Width of dirt course..... 90 feet

Training Hours – Main Track

Regular training hours will commence at 5:30 a.m. and conclude at 10:30 a.m. There will be two half-hour breaks, from 6:50 a.m. – 7:15 a.m., and again from 8:20 a.m. – 8:45 a.m. Announcements alerting horsemen to upcoming breaks will be made by security personnel at 6:40 a.m., 8:10 a.m., and 10:15 a.m., respectively. At the appropriate times, the outriders will clear all horses from the track to ensure that the tractors are able to harrow the surface in a timely manner.

Turf Course

The Gulfstream turf course base is composed of approximately 75% sand and 25% clay. The turf itself is grown directly into the base and is composed of Celebration Bermuda grass. Gulfstream is the only course in the nation that has Celebration. All others are composed of “419”.

The turf is cultivated in such a way that the grass grows together to form an excellent cushion.

AN IMPORTANT NOTE WITH RESPECT TO MEDICATION WITHDRAWAL TIME GUIDELINES

The Sunshine Millions™ races held at Santa Anita Park will be conducted in accordance with and subject to the medication rules and regulations of the California Horse Racing Board.

The Sunshine Millions™ races held at Gulfstream Park will be conducted in accordance with and subject to the medication rules and regulations of the Florida Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering.

As so many variables can affect withdrawal time (such as dose, route of administration, frequency of use, time of last meal, pH of urine, etc.), withdrawal time guidelines are usually significantly longer than the longest reported detection time. While significantly reducing the risk of post race detection, these guidelines are not guaranteed to entirely eliminate detections. For example, the oral administration of clenbuterol twice a day at the 0.8mcg/kg dose *should* be safe with a five-day withdrawal time prior to racing, but there is no guarantee.

Trainers are urged to consult with their attending veterinarians for more information on this subject.

In consideration of the Charterer agreeing to allow one or more horses (collectively, the "Cargo") owned by the undersigned (the "Owner") to participate in the Sunshine Millions™ event, arranging for the transportation of the Cargo through an independent third party carrier (the "Carrier") and such carriers as the carrier may engage, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Owner, intending to be legally bound, hereby acknowledges, confirms, warrants and agrees as follows:

1. **THE OWNER HEREBY VOLUNTARILY AND EXPRESSLY ASSUMES ALL RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH THE TRANSPORTATION AND HANDLING OF THE CARGO IN CONNECTION WITH THE SUNSHINE MILLIONS™ EVENT**, including (without limitation) the risk of injury, sickness or death of any horse, subject only to any claims which the Owner may have against parties other than the Charterer.
2. **THE OWNER HAS ADEQUATE INSURANCE COVERAGE IN EFFECT**, both in scope and amount, to fully protect its interests in the Cargo in the event of any mishap or other event that may occur in connection with the transportation or handling of the Cargo and acknowledges that the Charterer has not purchased any cargo liability accident or other insurance coverage for the Owner's benefit.
3. **THE OWNER HEREBY IRREVOCABLY AND UNCONDITIONALLY WAIVES AND RELEASES**, on behalf of itself and any party who may now or hereafter be entitled to assert a claim by or through the Owner, **ANY AND ALL CLAIMS** that the Owner or any such party otherwise might have now or in the future against the Charterer and/or its directors, officers, employees and agents (collectively, the "Released Parties") for or in respect of any loss, damage or injury of any kind, including (without limitation) the injury, sickness or death of any horse, which is caused or incurred in any way as a result of or in connection with the transportation or handling of the Cargo in connection with the Sunshine Millions™ event that is being promoted by the Charterer.

4. **THE OWNER HEREBY IRREVOCABLY AND UNCONDITIONALLY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS THE RELEASED PARTIES** from and against any and all claims, actions, costs, damages, expenses, injuries, liabilities or losses (collectively, “Losses”) that the Released Parties, or any of them, may suffer or incur in any way as a result of or in connection with the transportation or handling of the Cargo in connection with the Sunshine Millions™ event that is being promoted by the Charterer, regardless of the nature of the Loss and however caused, including (without limitation) any Loss that may result from any negligence or breach of any applicable statutory duty on the part of any one or more of the Released Parties.
5. This Express Assumption of Risk, Waiver of Liability and Release of Charterer shall enure to the benefit of the Charterer and its successors and assigns, shall be binding on the Owner and its heirs, executors, administrators, legal personal representatives, successors and assigns and shall be governed by the laws of the State of **[California] [Florida]**¹.
