CALIFORNIA CUP XXI

California Cup XXI will be held Saturday, October 30, at Santa Anita Park and co-hosts of the event which spotlights the California Thoroughbred racing and breeding industry—the California Thoroughbred Breeders Association and the Oak Tree Racing Association—are confident that California Cup Day again will be one of the premier racing days of the year in California.
