Multiple stakes winner Ain't No Other is the leading earner among five California-breds entered in Saturday's \$50,000 Oakland Stakes at Golden Gate Fields.

Ourwestcoastghost is by Muqtarib, out of the In Excess (Ire) mare Xpress Xcess, was bred by owners Ron and Lillian Lang and D. Wayne Baker and is trained by Baker. He has four wins in nine starts, earnings of \$135,212 and is coming off a fourth in an October 20 allowance.

Ain't No Other is by Tommy Town Thoroughbreds' Old Topper, out of the Shadeed mare Miami Margie, was bred by owner Tommy Town Thoroughbreds and is trained by Jerry Hollendorfer. He has nine wins in 30 starts, earnings of \$540,465 and is coming off a second in the October 19 California Flag. He was third in this race last year.

Coach Bob is by Bertrando, out of the Yankee Gentleman mare Gentleman's Hope, was bred by Pam and Marty Wygod, is owned by Tom Gerstel, Reina Gonzalez, Keith Hembree, Jean Hembree, et al. He has four wins in 27 starts, earnings of \$172,748 and is coming off a sixth in an October 20 allowance.

Mel's Game is by E.A. Ranches' Game Plan, out of the Malek (Chi) mare Melinda Rose, was bred by owner Nick Alexander and is trained by Mike Mitchell. He has three wins in seven starts, earnings of \$133,016 and is making his first start since a June 8 optional claimer.

Starboardlights is by Helmsman, out of the Allen's Prospect mare Allitup, was bred by Leland Garner, is owned by Stewball Stable and Kristin Finkel and is trained by Valerie Rhoden. He has four wins in 24 starts, earnings of \$208,339 and is coming off a second in the August 10 Jess Jackson Owners' Handicap.

Cal-Bred Pair Sell Well During Thursday Session Of The Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale

A pair of California-breds were six-figure purchases at Thursday's session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale.

Starlight Magic, a four-year-old filly by Rancho San Miguel's Marino Marini, out of the General Meeting mare Star's Millennium, was consigned by Greenfield Farm, agent and purchased by Woodford Thoroughbreds for \$130,000. The broodmare prospect won the Robert H. Walter California Cup Juvenile Fillies, Fleet Treat Stakes and \$334,900.

Smooth Performer, an eight-year-old mare by Ballena Vista Farm's Benchmark, out of the Bertrando mare Smooth Player, was consigned by Lane's End, agent for Pam and Marty Wygod and purchased by Windways Farm for \$120,000. The stakes winner of \$247,900 is in foal to City Zip.

Unusual Heat's Stud Fee Set

Unusual Heat, the five-time leading sire in California (2008-2012) and six-time leading sire of California-breds (2008-2013), will again stand in 2014 at Harris Farms in Coalinga, California, for \$20,000 to approved mares only.

In 2013, Unusual Heat was represented by eight stakes

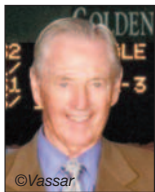

Square Eddie's 2014 book will be limited to 70 mares, consisting of 35 of Reddam's mares and 35 approved outside mares.

Square Eddie is a seven-year-old Ontario-bred son of Smart Strike, winner of the grade I Lane's End Breeders' Futurity, runner-up in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile and earner of \$856,042. As a five-year-old, he set the Santa Anita Park track record for 6 1/2 furlongs at 1:13.11.

His first crop to race are two-year-olds this year, headed by multiple stakes winner Sprouts, who took the Cinderella and California Thoroughbred Breeders' Association Stakes. The crop also includes stakes-placed Eddies Curl, Smoove It and Electric Eddie.

winners including stakes-winning Breeders' Cup Mile participant He Be Fire N' Ice. Other prominent runners included grade II-placed stakes winners Gervinho and Unusual Way along with grade II-placed Huntsville. Unusual Heat was also represented by Golden State Series stakes winners Surfcup, Unusual Hottie and U'narack.

Unusual Heat set the all-time California record for progeny earnings in 2008 with over \$5.8 million and was again the California earnings champion for 2009, 2010, 2011 and 2012. He is currently battling for leading sire in California in 2013 with over \$4 million in progeny earnings, achieving that milestone for a sixth consecutive season in California. This also marks Unusual Heat's 10th consecutive California-bred North American Turf Earnings Championship. He has sired one Eclipse Award winner and 13 California champions.

Next year will be Unusual Heat's fourth season standing at Harris Farms. The son of Nureyev, 24 next year, successfully covered a full book of mares in 2013. He has sired 10 graded stakes winners, 24 graded stakes horses, 42 stakes winners and 117 earners of over \$100,000 from just 453 starters. He is part of the Harris Farms stallion roster that includes Lucky Pulpit, Thorn Song, Tizbud, Desert Code, Lucky J. H. and Heatseeker (Ire).

Idealistic Cause was the fourth of 12 foals out of the Cresta Rider mare Special Idea. The Flawlessly was Idealistic Cause's seventh win in 18 starts. She won three other stakes, placed in five more and finished her career with eight wins in 31 starts and earnings of \$308,377. Idealistic Cause was bred by Mr. and Mrs. John Mabee, was foaled at Golden Eagle Ranch in Ramona and was owned by Larry Cassaday and Jack Thompson. As a broodmare, Idealistic Cause has seven foals, including millionaire Interpatation, winner of the grade I Joe Hirsch Turf Classic.
