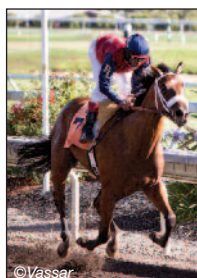

Cal-bred Pair In Zia Park Oaks



California-breds Unusual Way and Comic Kitty are entered in Sunday's \$300,000 Zia Park Oaks for three-year-old fillies.

Unusual Way is by Harris Farms' Unusual Heat, out of the Great Above mare Way Up, was bred by Thomas Bachman, is owned by Edward Brown Jr. and Philip Lebherz and is trained by Jeff Bonde. She has four wins in 13 starts, earnings of \$408,360 and is coming off a ninth in the September 28 Unzip Me Stakes.

Comic Kitty is by Grey's Farm's Comic Strip, out of the Tabasco Cat mare Catalass, was bred by Dr. and Mrs. William Gray, is owned by UKUSA Stables and trained by Eric Mikkelsen. She has two wins in 14 starts, earnings of \$26,273 and is coming off an October 23 allowance win.

Real Heat In Zia Park Derby

Real Heat is the lone California-bred entered in Sunday's \$200,000 Zia Park Derby for three-year-olds.

Real Heat is by Harris Farms' Unusual Heat, out of the Ole mare Chi Chi Nette, was bred by Madeline Auerbach and Barry Abrams, is owned by Class Racing Stable and trained by Bart Hone.

He has two wins in 13 starts, earnings of \$88,370 and is coming off an October 22 allowance win.

Cal-bred Pair In Zia Park Distaff

California-breds Warren's Venedalucy and Wine Thief are entered in Sunday's \$55,000 Zia Park Distaff Stakes for fillies and mares.

Warren's Venedalucy is by Doc Gus, out of the Carson City mare State the Obvious, was bred by Benjamin Warren, is owned by Ace Racing Stable and trained by Justin Evans. She has four wins in 21 starts, earnings of \$105,490 and is coming off a win in a November 6 optional claimer.

Wine Thief is by Ballena Vista Farms's Benchmark, out of the French Parliament mare Malbay Slew, was bred by Robert and Eileen Osaki and West 12 Ranch, is owned by SEJ Stables and is trained by Justin Evans. She has six wins in 22 starts, earnings of \$117,035 and is coming off a consecutive wins in optional claimers.

Warren's Veneda Wins Cat's Cradle



Favored Warren's Veneda pulled clear turning for home to win the \$100,000 Cat's Cradle for Golden State Series eligible fillies and mares at Betfair Hollywood Park on November 17.

Warren's Veneda is by Farrell W. Jones Thoroughbred Farm's Affirmative, out of the Flying Continental mare More Cal Bread, was bred by owner Benjamin Warren and is trained by Craig Lewis.

She has five wins in 10 starts, earnings of \$277,064 and was coming off a win in an October 13 optional claimer.

Warren's Veneda ran the 7 1/2 furlongs in 1:29.72 and won by a length at odds of 6-5. Curvy Cat was second and Sister Kate was third in the field of five.

The North American International Catalogue Standards Committee (NAICSC) today issued a reminder that effective January 1, 2014, additional quality control requirements will be implemented for races in North America eligible for non-Listed black-type in catalogues compliant with guidelines required by the Society of International Thoroughbred Auctioneers (SITA).

The NAICSC establishes the requirements for non-Listed black type races in sales catalogues produced in North America that are compliant with guidelines required by SITA.

Races eligible for non-Listed black-type status include stakes races with a purse of \$50,000 or more that are open or have restrictions allowed by NAICSC (e.g., state bred, stallions' progeny, sales graduates or non-winners of a sweepstakes).

The new requirements, which were first announced in November 2012, include the addition of a minimum Race Quality Score (RQS) for individual age/sex divisions. Statistics

used in the evaluation of Graded and Listed races, including ratings provided by the North American Rating Committee, are not available for non-Listed black-type races. The RQS provides an alternative quality control measurement for these races.

The RQS is a composite number compiled by using speed figures for the first four finishers in each race over three years. Four speed figures are used to compile the RQS and are provided by Bloodstock Research Information Systems (BRIS), Daily Racing Form (Beyer), Equibase and Thoro-Graph.
